

Total Walpole ARPA Allocation



Under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), Massachusetts state, county, tribal and local entities receive federal aid to respond to the public health and economic impacts of the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Eligible uses:

- Expenses to respond to the public health emergency or negative economic impacts
- Premium pay to employees providing essential work during the emergency
- Revenue replacement and compliance
- Water, sewer, and broadband projects

At this time funds must be committed through <u>December 31, 2024</u>, and expended by <u>December 31, 2026</u>.


US Treasury Allocation \$2,637,648
