## **Minutes of Meeting**

### **April 5, 2022**

The Board of Assessors met on Tuesday, April 5, 2022, at 4:00 pm, via zoom. The following Board members were present: John Fisher, Chair, Robert Bushway, Clerk and Richard Zaccaro, Member. Also participating, Dennis Flis, Director of Assessing.

Executive Order on Remote Participation. On Thursday, March 12, 2020, Governor Baker issued an “Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting G.L.c 30A, Section 20. That order was effective immediately and until it is rescinded, or the State of Emergency is terminated. The Governor has authorized remote Participation for all public boards due to the Emergency declaration order that was issued on March 12, 2020. Every vote taken will be taken by roll call vote.

The Board after reviewing and discussing, voted 3-0-0, to deny the following applications for abatements:
