### Old Business

### A. Recreation Department Summer Proposal

### - <u>Pools</u>

Director Croak presented the Committee with the revised proposal that outlines how the department will safely and financially open the Town Pools for summer of 2020. Pool capacity will still be limited to 60%. Social distancing will still be required while visiting the town pools. This includes the pool deck, restroom areas, as well as in the water.

The revised proposal divides the pools into one-hour time block reservations that would require pre-registration at \$14 per family (up to four members). After sending out a survey to previous patrons of the pool, Director Croak mentioned that there appears to be a demand for pool usage by members of this public this summer.

Both Chairperson Grant and Town Administrator Johnson wanted to make sure that the Department continues to monitor how the proposal goes throughout the summer. The Department shall make adjustments, as needed in order to continue to offer this service to the public.
