## Walpole Recycling Information For Residents with Municipal Trash Collection

### Curbside Collection Information

#### Paper

Place in weatherproof **Open** containers.

- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines, catalogs
- Phone books, junk mail
- Office paper
- Paperboard (cereal, cracker boxes). Remove plastic liners
- Corrugated cardboard, flatten, must fit in a recycle bin or brown paper bag (2'x2' max)
- Brown paper bags
- **NO** plastic bags
- **NO** Dirty Pizza Boxes (ONLY CLEAN boxes may be recycled if cut up)

#### Containers

Place in weatherproof **Open** containers.

- Glass bottles/jars, all colors & sizes
- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- Aluminum foil/pie plates
- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- Plastic food and beverage containers labeled
- **NO** Styrofoam
- **NO** packing materials, **NO** plastic trays
- **NO** plastic bags
- **NO** items containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials
- **NO** broken glass, window glass, dishes, Pyrex, ceramics

### Drop-Off/Special Collections

#### Yard Waste - Must obtain sticker from Collector's office

- Leaves, grass, other easily raked materials.
- Drop-off days: Wednesdays, year round, 9AM-12PM.
- Open Saturdays - Spring, Summer and Fall, please check with the Board of Health for times. Check the Walpole Town website.

#### Electronics (Drop-off by Appt. only)

- TVs, computers, Fluorescent Bulbs
- Call (508) 660-7321 for appt & prices

#### Christmas Trees (Curbside)

- Remove tinsel, twine, ornaments
- 1st 2 weeks of January by DPW

#### Corrugated Cardboard

- Corrugated cardboard at drop-off can be larger than 2'x2'

#### Fluorescent light bulbs

- No charge at Rocky's Ace Hardware (653 Main St)
- No eight foot lengths, No Compact Fluorescent

### Curbside Recycling Collection Schedule

Recycling is collected every other week on your regular trash day. Mon-Fri. Shaded week residents have their recycling collected on weeks shaded. Non-shaded week residents have their recycling collected on weeks that are not shaded.

#### Holiday Schedule

When a scheduled collection day falls on a circled holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day (See calendar). Friday's collection will be on Saturday. Holidays are circled. Christmas and New Year's weeks on regular collection.
