
WEST ST. WALPOLE (WALPOLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY) 6:30 PM

The Building Commissioner Mr. Jack Mee has notified the Walpole Historical Commission of a request to demolish the barn structure(s) at **765 WASHINGTON ST., WALPOLE, MASSACHUSETTS**. The request has been made by Ms. Marylyn R. Ryan, Trustee. The property was reviewed by the Commission on 27 September, 2014, at 8:30 am. During an open meeting held by the Commission at the Walpole Historical Society at 9:30 am later that morning, a motion was made & unanimously approved by the attending Commission membership that *the barn is architecturally & historically significant to the Town of Walpole*, and that a demolition cannot proceed until a public hearing is held.

Per the Walpole Demolition Delay By-Law, a public hearing is to be held Thursday, October 23, 2014, to further discuss this determination. The public is invited to attend.

Also, per the Walpole Demolition Delay By-Law public notice of this meeting is to be made in a local newspaper by the current owners of the property or their representatives, at least 7 working days before this hearing (by October 14, 2014).

The cost of that newspaper notice is to be paid for by the applicant.
