At a meeting of the County Commissioners, held at Dedham, within and for said County of Norfolk, on the eight day of January A.D. 2014, by adjournment of their December meeting next preceding: A notice of said meeting having been posted as required by law:

UPON THE PETITION OF Maureen Petrosky and others, inhabitants of the town of SHARON in said County, representing that common convenience and necessity require that a portion of High Plain Street, a public way in said town be discontinued as shown on a plan prepared by Merrikin Associates, dated May 12, 2008 WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY that said discontinuance may be made within the limits above specified.

On the Petition aforesaid, ORDERED, that the County Commissioners will meet at the Administrative Offices, 614 High Street in Dedham, Massachusetts on Wednesday January 29, 2014 at 1:30 o'clock P.M. and thence proceed to view the route described in said petition, (if they consider it expedient Or if requested by any party interested) and to hear and act on said petition.

And that an attested copy of said petition, with this order thereon, be served upon the Clerk of the Towns of SHARON and WALPOLE Fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view:

ORDERED, that the County Commissioners will meet at the Administrative Offices, 614 High Street in Dedham on Wednesday, January 29, 2014 at 1:30 o'clock P.M. and thence proceed to view the route described in said petition, (if they consider it expedient or if requested by any party interested) and to hear and act on said petition.

And that an attested copy of said petition, with this order thereon, be served upon the Clerk of the Towns of Sharon and Walpole fifteen days at least before the time appointed for said view; and also that a copy of an abstract of said petition be published in the Sharon Advocate and Walpole Times newspapers printed at Framingham and posted up in two or more public places in Sharon and Walpole such publication and posting to be seven days at least before said view, that all persons and corporations interested for or against said petition may then appear and be heard if they see fit.
