**Notice of Intent & Site Plan Approval – League School - 300 Boston Providence Highway: Documents/Exhibits – Notice of Intent (on file Conservation Commission); Site Plan (on file Planning Board); Deputy Health Agent's summary.**

The Board of Health reviewed for comment the Notice of Intent and Site Plan Approval applications for the expansion of an existing school building, construction of another free standing building, associated signage, lighting, parking, pedestrian walkways and landscaping at the League School, 300 Boston Providence Highway.

**MOTION:** made by Carol Johnson that the Board of Health's comment to both the Planning Board and Conservation Commission is that we have no concerns regarding the proposed expansion of the League School. Seconded by Richard Bringhurst.

**MOTION AMENDMENT:** made by Claire Wolfram that the Board of Health is also pleased to see lighted walkways included in the plan. VOTE: 5-0-0 UNANIMOUS.

**Town Administration Recommendation – Fiscal Year 2014 Budget:**

The Health Director informed the Board of Health that the Town Administrator has approved including a new part time position in the Health Department's FY14 Administrative Budget and made only minor cuts to the department's Operating Budget.

The Health Director said that the Walpole Coalition for Alcohol and Drug Awareness video contest ends tonight at midnight. Ms. Chapell said that along with middle and high school student entries, this year 5<sup>th</sup> grade students may also enter.

**CDC Vital Signs – Binge Drinking:**

The Board of Health reviewed a recent report published in CDC's Vital Signs, January 2013 edition, regarding the serious under recognized problem of binge drinking among women and girls.
