Notes

*Due to a lack of quorum, no official meeting was held and no votes were taken. The following is a summary of what took place.

Attendees: Ed Forsberg (Chairman), Dick Power (Vice Chairman), Mike Amaral, Dick Nottebart and Roger Turner. Staff Present: Stephanie Mercandetti (left at 7:00pm) and Maura Therrien. Guests: Sue Ferioli and Denise Maleiko.

Discussion started at 6:40p.m.

Due to a lack of quorum, the draft minutes will be discussed at the next meeting.

Spring Brook Trail/Park Project Update: The proper bolts have been supplied by the Raven's Marine, bridge manufacturer, at no cost. These will be used to put in the handrails. A request has been sent to the Board of Selectmen for appointments for both the Lions Club and the Walpole Chamber of Commerce to appear before the Board to present donations for the Spring Brook Park Project. Both Ed Forsberg, representing the Lions Club, and Beth Pelick, representing the Chamber, will be in attendance at the Selectmen's meeting on Tuesday, April 15th. The Lions Club has donated \$5,000.00 in memory of the late David Murphy to build the first ramada. The Chamber of Commerce raised funds for lighting and other improvements. Sullivan Concrete will donate two cement benches and pads. Lighting for the project was also discussed. Pricing for the two ramadas were received: \$14,275.00 from DB&S, \$16,000.00 from Koopman Lumber, and Chase Supply will give a discount of \$8,700.00 for materials only. The pricing is for Red Cedar, which looks good and lasts. Pressure treated lumber will crack and splinter. Anticipated delivery is four to six weeks. Chase charges \$5,000.00 each delivered prefab and assembled on site, without shingles or braces, notched in place. Northeastern University Students will provide signage. The Committee was informed that Conservation Agent Landis Hershey is concerned about erosion. In addition, Denise Maleiko noted that she is seeing more water than before in surrounding fields. The Board of Selectmen wants to notify abutters concerning this project. They have asked Mike to respond to their request.

All other items were held until the next meeting scheduled for Tuesday, May 13th.
