SATURDAY, JUNE 3, 2017

<u>EVENT</u>	<u>DEADLINE OR DATE REQUIRED</u>
First day to obtain nomination papers	Wednesday, February 1, 2017
Last day for RTM incumbents to file Letter of Intent to run for re-election (Nomination papers are NOT required if deadline is met)	Monday, April 10, 2017 – 5:00 PM
Last day to obtain nomination papers:	Thursday, April 13, 2017 – 5:00 PM
Last day to submit nomination papers to Board of Registrars for certification*	Tuesday, April 18, 2017 – 5:00 PM
Last day to submit certified papers with Town Clerk (*filing with the Board of Registrars meets this requirement)	Monday, May 1, 2017
Last day to object or withdraw	Wednesday, May 3, 2017 – 5:00 PM
Last day to register to vote in Annual Town Election	Friday, May 12, 2017 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM
Annual Town Election	Saturday, June 3, 2017 Polls Open 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM

***50 CERTIFIED SIGNATURES REQUIRED – NON RTM**

The required number of signatures for candidates for town wide office is set at 1% of the total number of voters in the last race for governor in Walpole. The total number of voters in the 2014 Governor's Race in Walpole was 10,762. MGL Ch 53, §6 states the # of signatures required cannot be less than 20 and no more than 50.

***25 CERTIFIED SIGNATURES REQUIRED – RTM** (Walpole Charter 2-6 (B))

CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORT (Form CPF M102) FILING SCHEDULE – NON RTM ONLY

PRE-ELECTION REPORT	due 8 days before election	Friday, May 26 th (closed at 12noon)
POST ELECTION REPORT	due 30 days after election	Monday, July 3 rd (closed)

Note: If you do not receive any contributions, spend any money (including your own) or incur any liabilities in connection with your campaign, you may sign Form CPF M102-0 (available at the Town Clerk's Office) for each reporting period in lieu of filing Form CPF M102
