Animal Permit Application-486 Washington Street:

Lifeguard Variance Fairfield Inn, 630 Boston Providence Highway:

The Board of Health reviewed the lifeguard variance request for Fairfield Inn.

MOTION: Made by Richard Beauregard that the Board of Health votes to continue the current lifeguard variance with the same conditions previously approved. These conditions require that a CPO (Certified Pool Operator) is available on site at all times the pool is open, warning signs are posted around the pool, children under the age of 16 shall not use the pool without adult supervision, guests using the pool check in at the front desk prior to entering the pool area, staff present are CPR Certified during all hours the pool is open. A standard indemnification agreement with the Town of Walpole Board of Health must be submitted. In addition, the Board would like to reiterate that the applicant must adhere to all COVID19 requirements pertaining to operating a swimming pool and or spa. **VOTE: 5-0-0 UNANIMOUS**
