







FEBRUARY OUTREACH BY CATEGORY





2023 Total Rides Per Month




TOTAL RIDES BY CATEGORY - FEBRUARY 2023




2023 Participant Check Ins




Total Participation YOY




Check in Count FY23




Check in by Age Group - February 2023




Average Daily Attendance FY23




In Town and Out of Town Participation



Female and Male Participation




