


December by the Numbers:

 - Family Member - 52


2023 Outreach Month Over Month



Outreach Year Over Year




JANUARY OUTREACH BY CATEGORY




2023 Total Rides Per Month




TOTAL RIDES BY CATEGORY - JANUARY 2023




2023 Participant Check Ins




Total Participation Year Over Year




Check in Count FY23




Check in by Age Group - January 2023



Average Daily Attendance FY23




In Town and Out of Town Participation




Female and Male Participation






