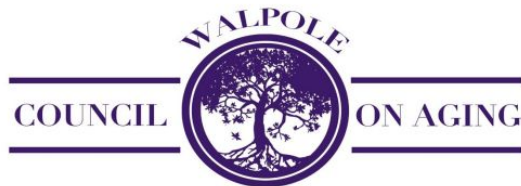

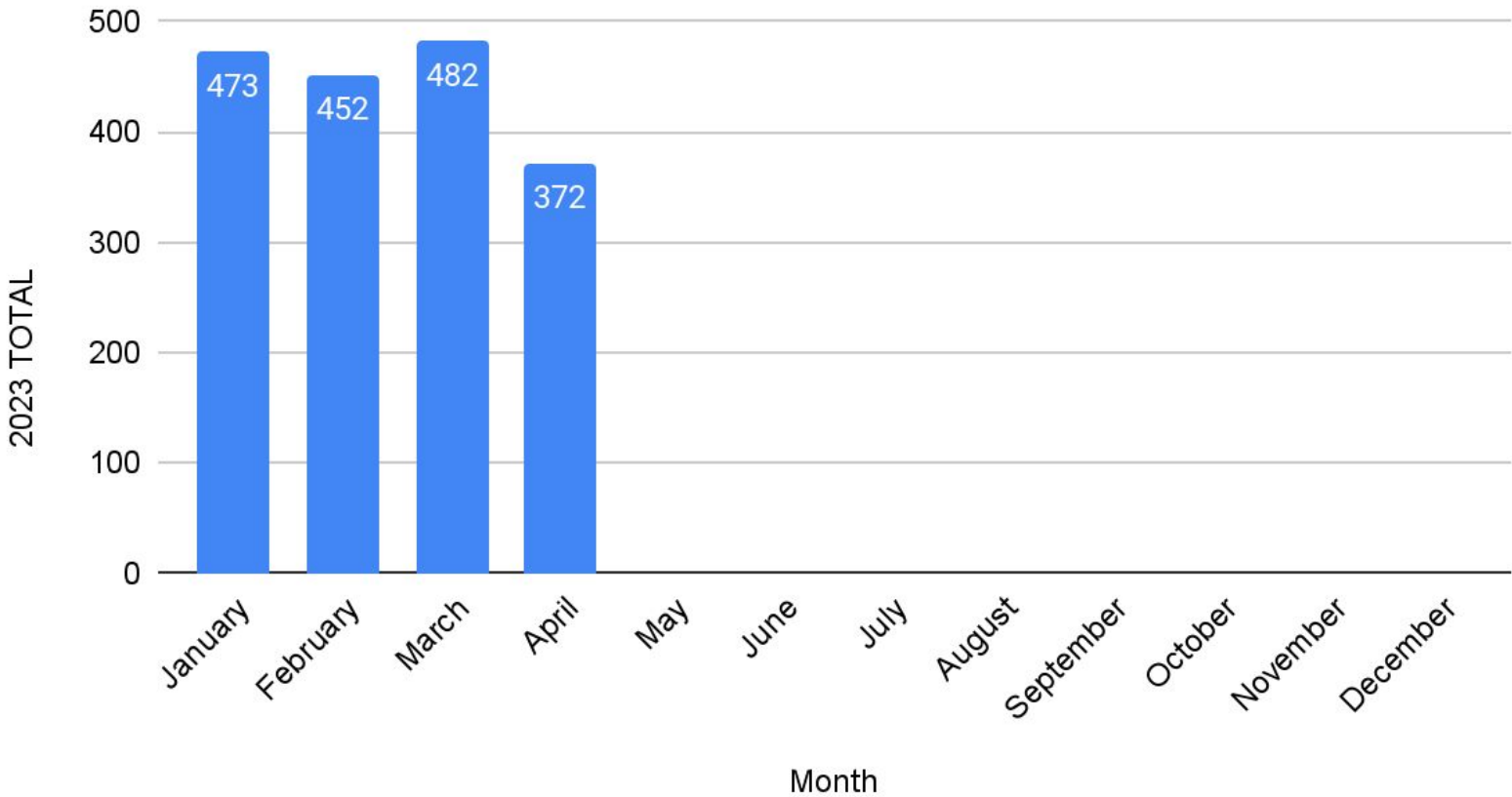

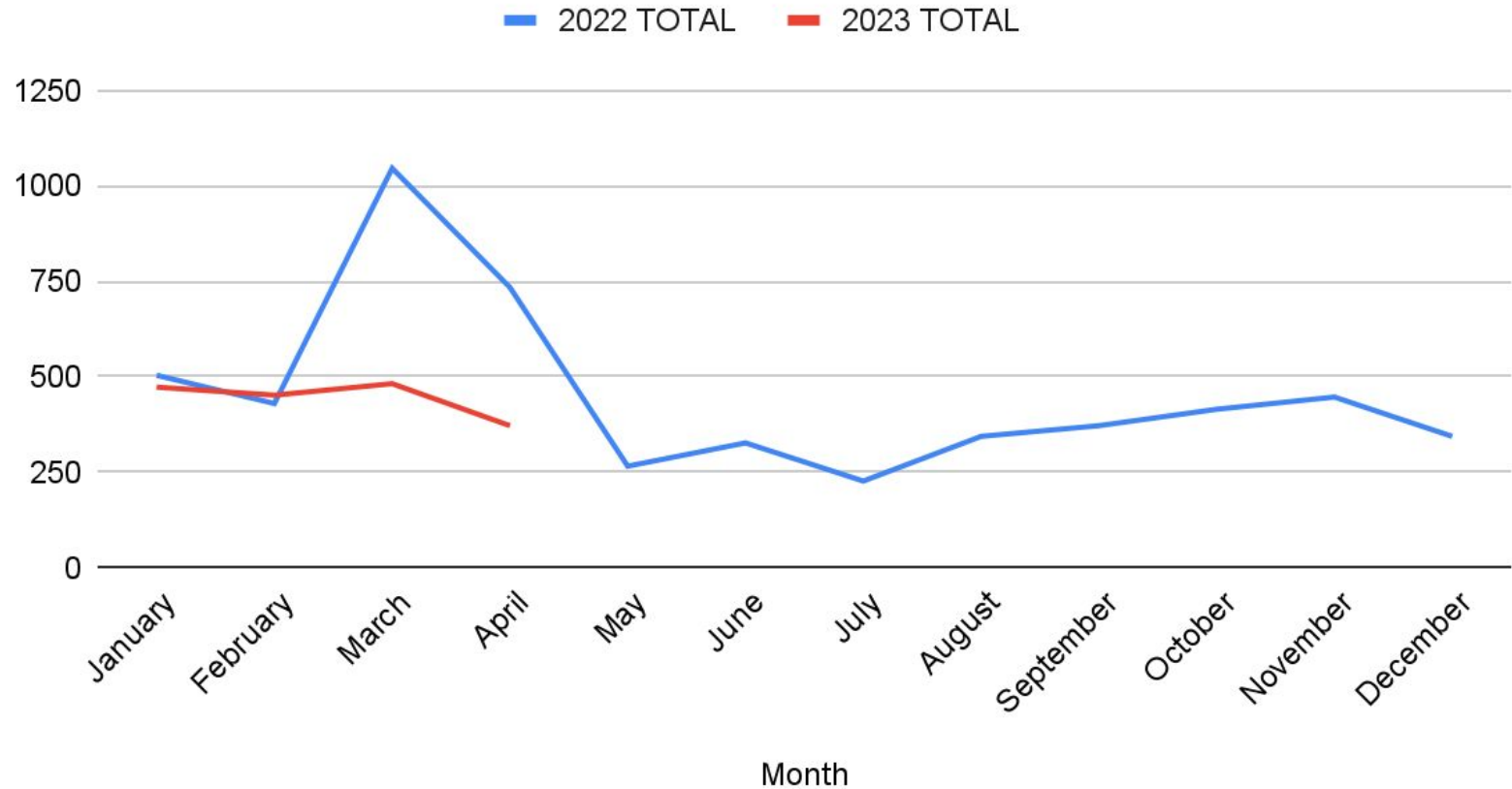
April by the Numbers:

 - Family Member - 27

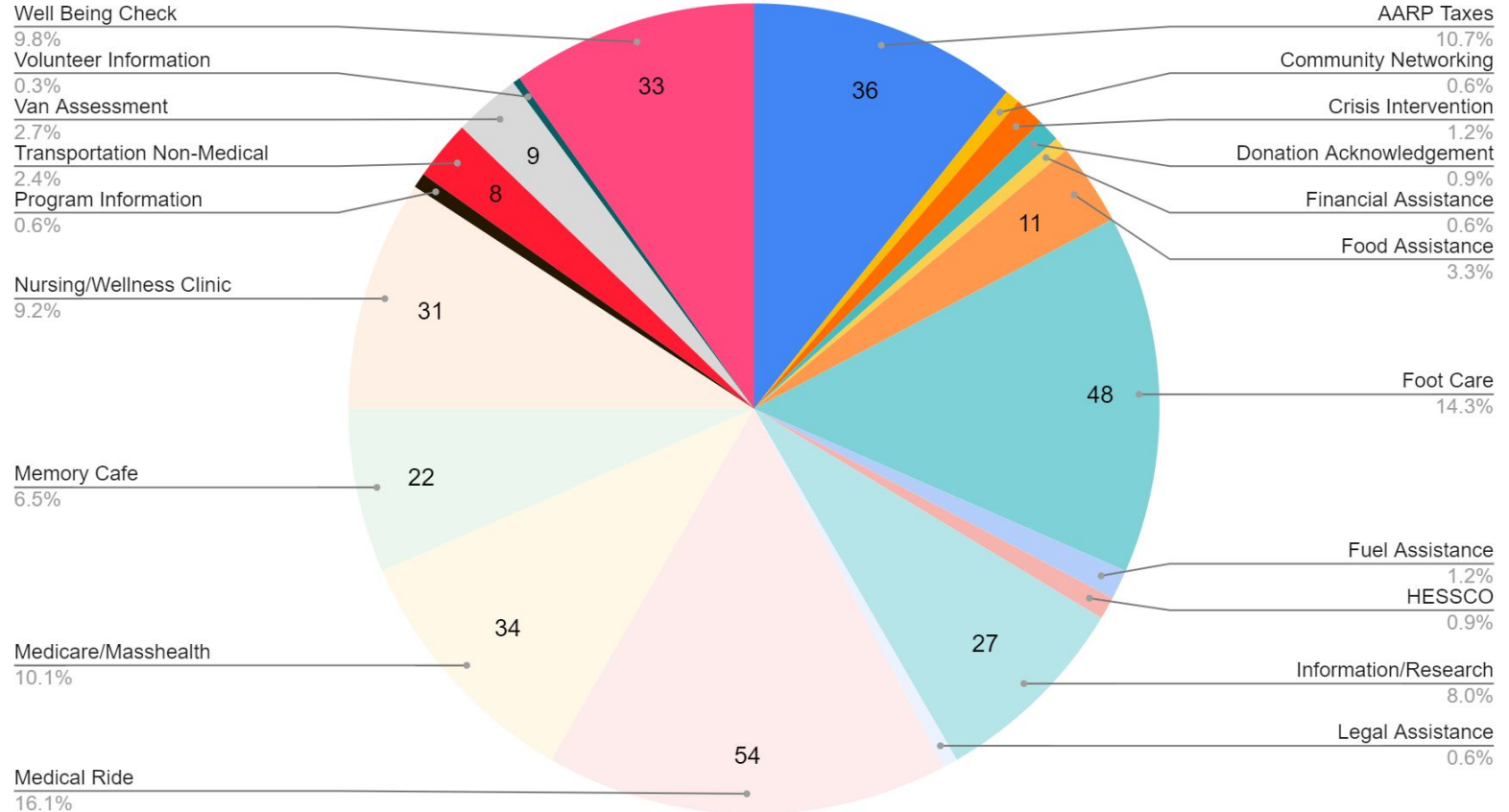
2023 Outreach Month Over Month

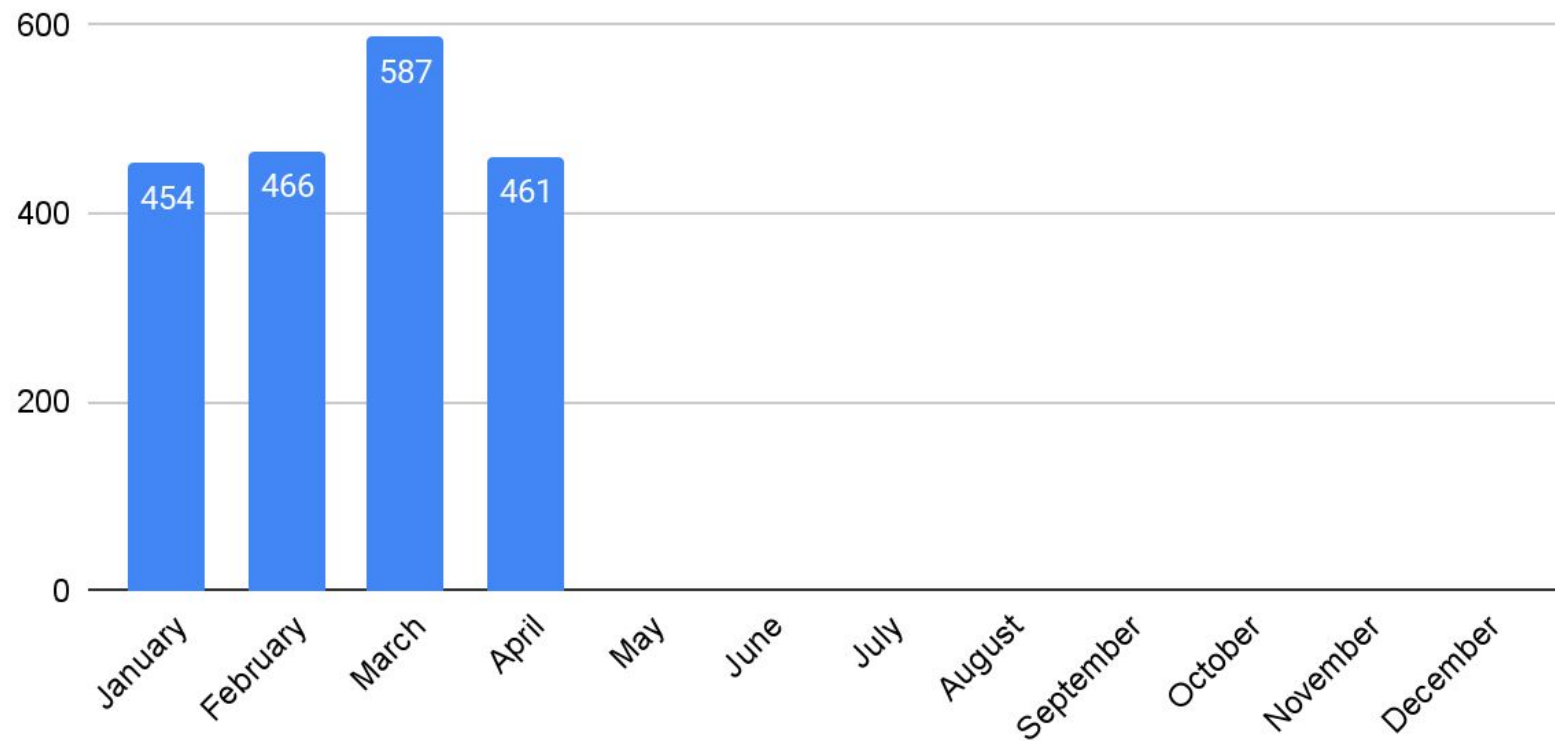


APRIL OUTREACH BY CATEGORY



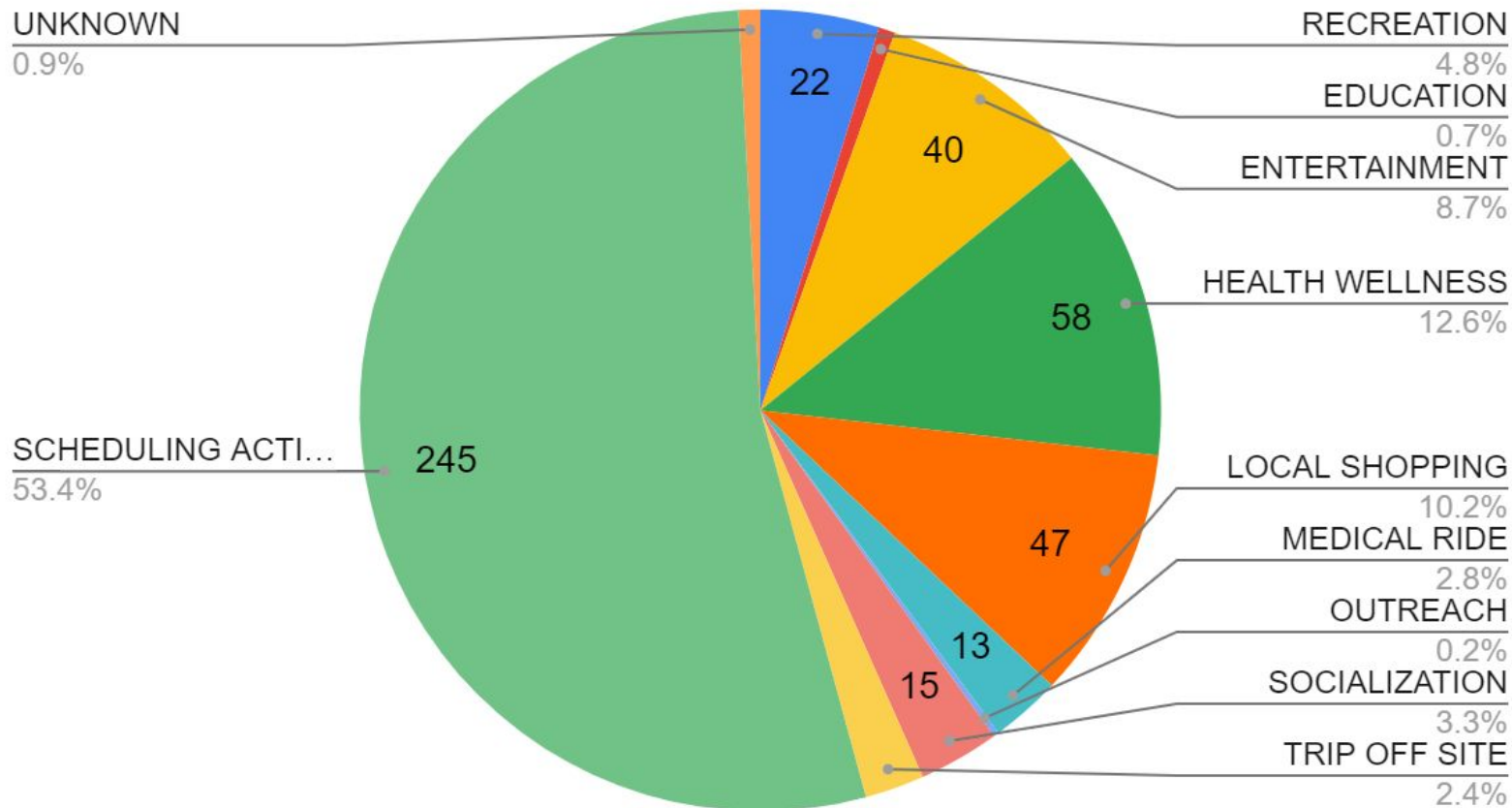

2023 Total Rides Per Month

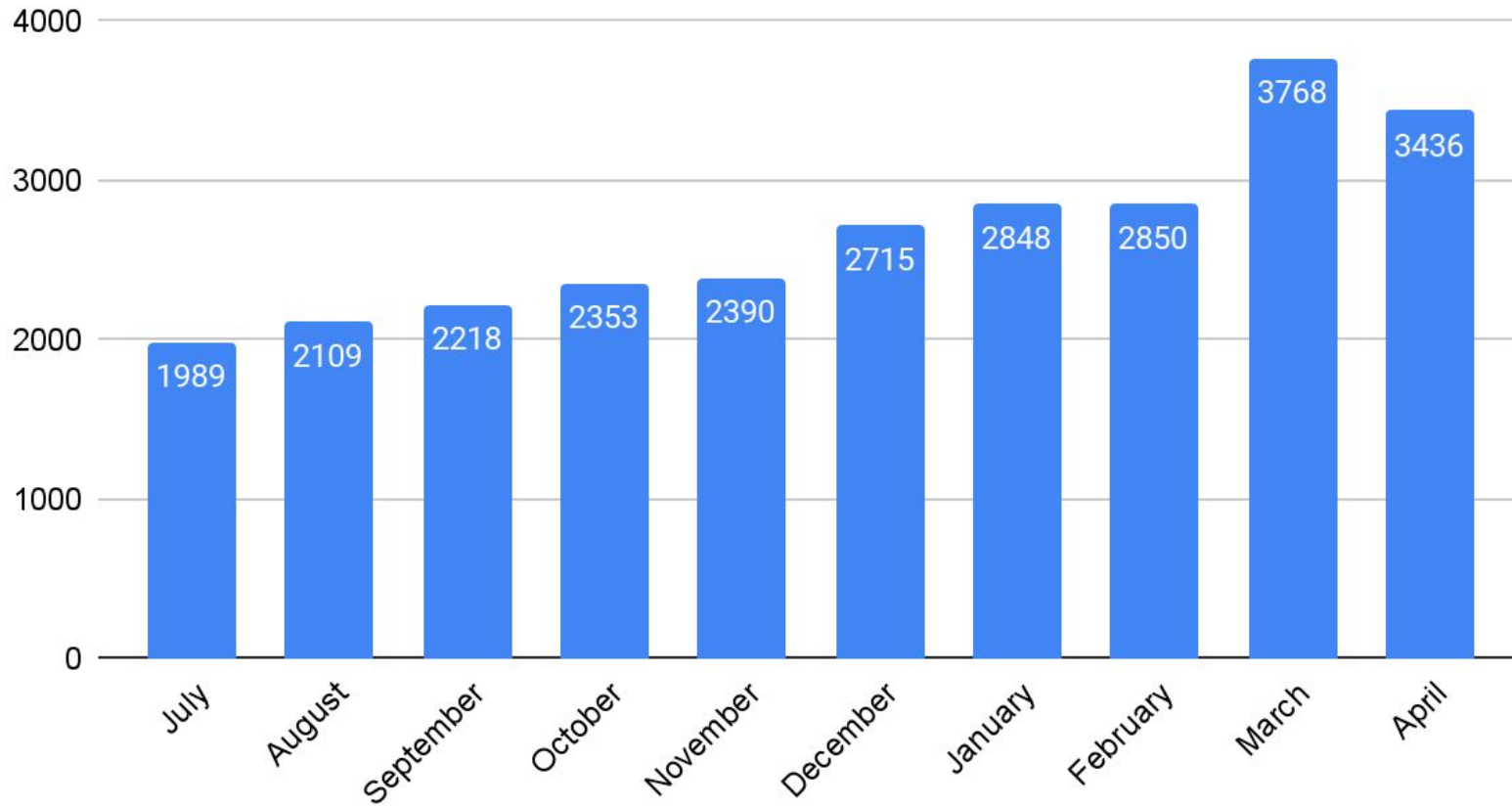

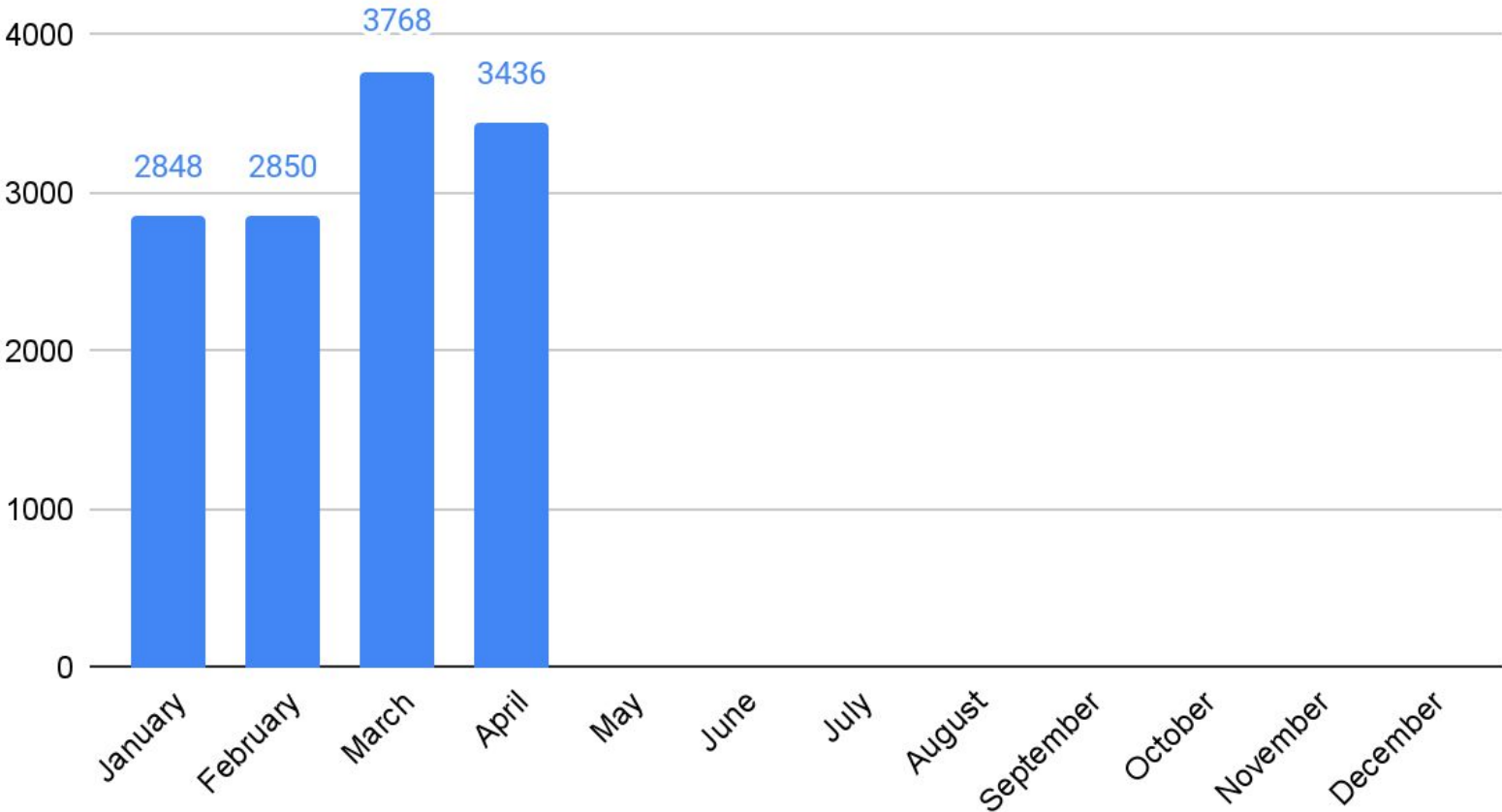
TOTAL RIDES BY CATEGORY - April 2023



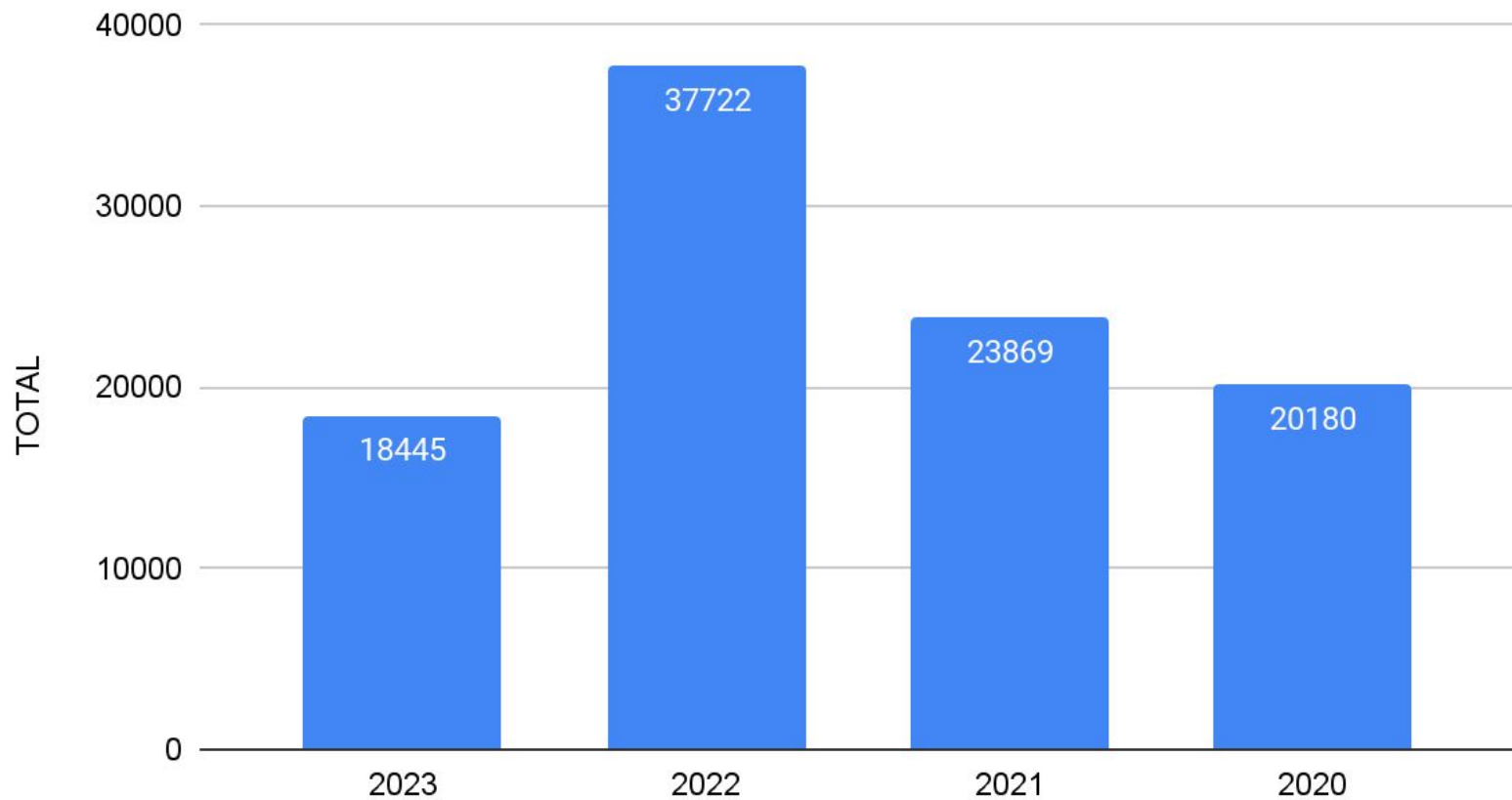
Check in Count FY23



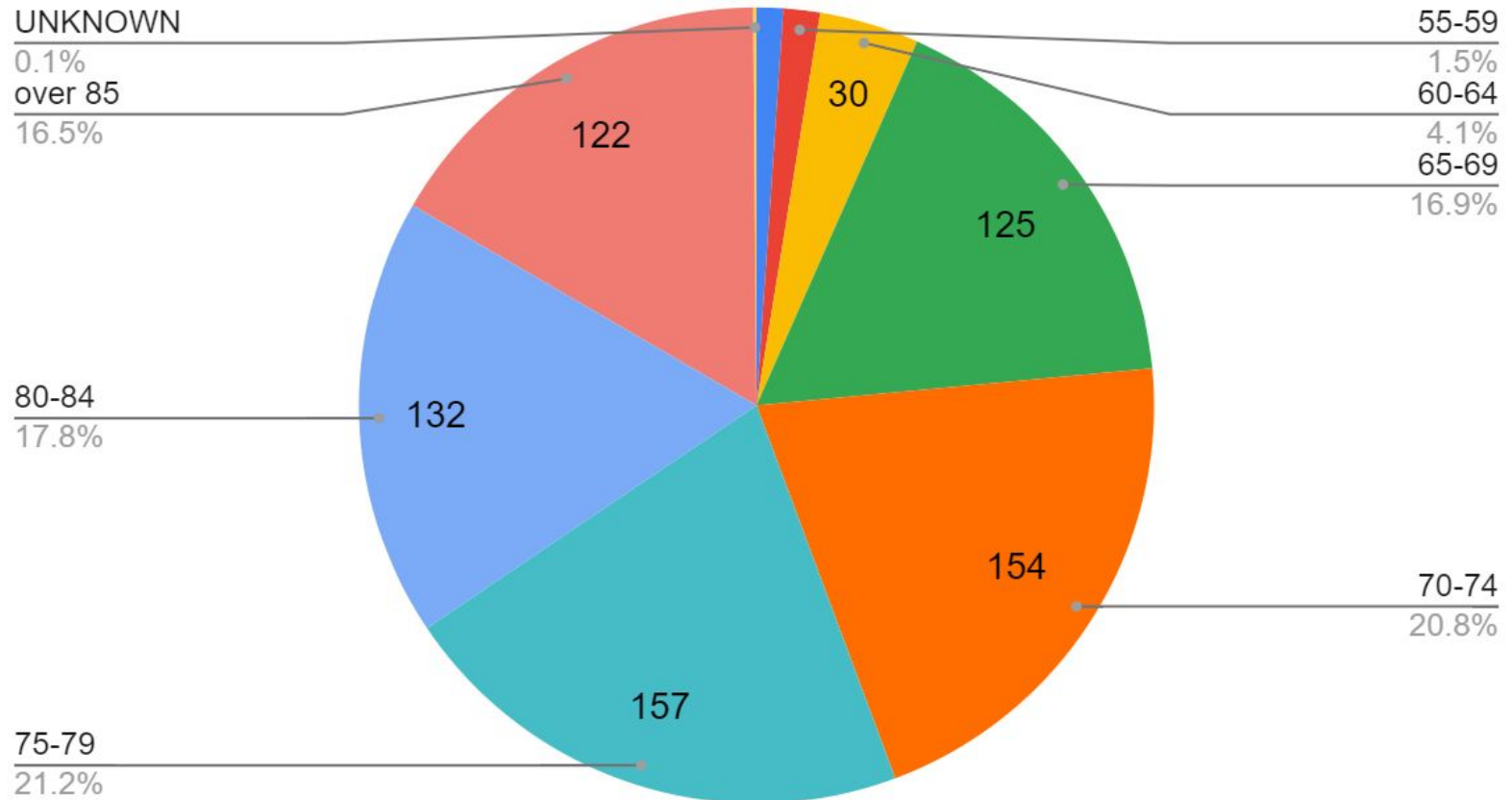
2023 Participant Check Ins



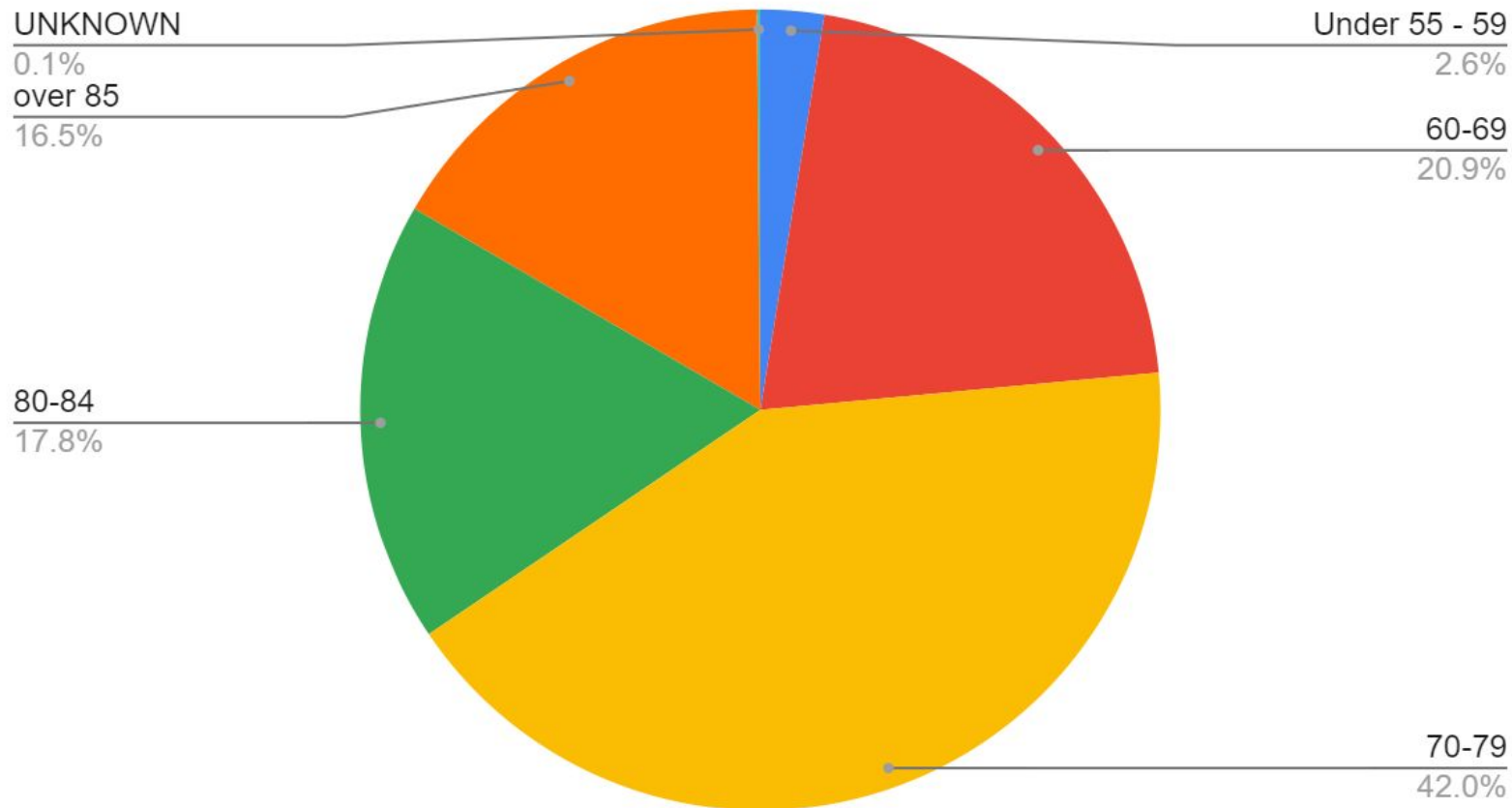
Total Participation YOY



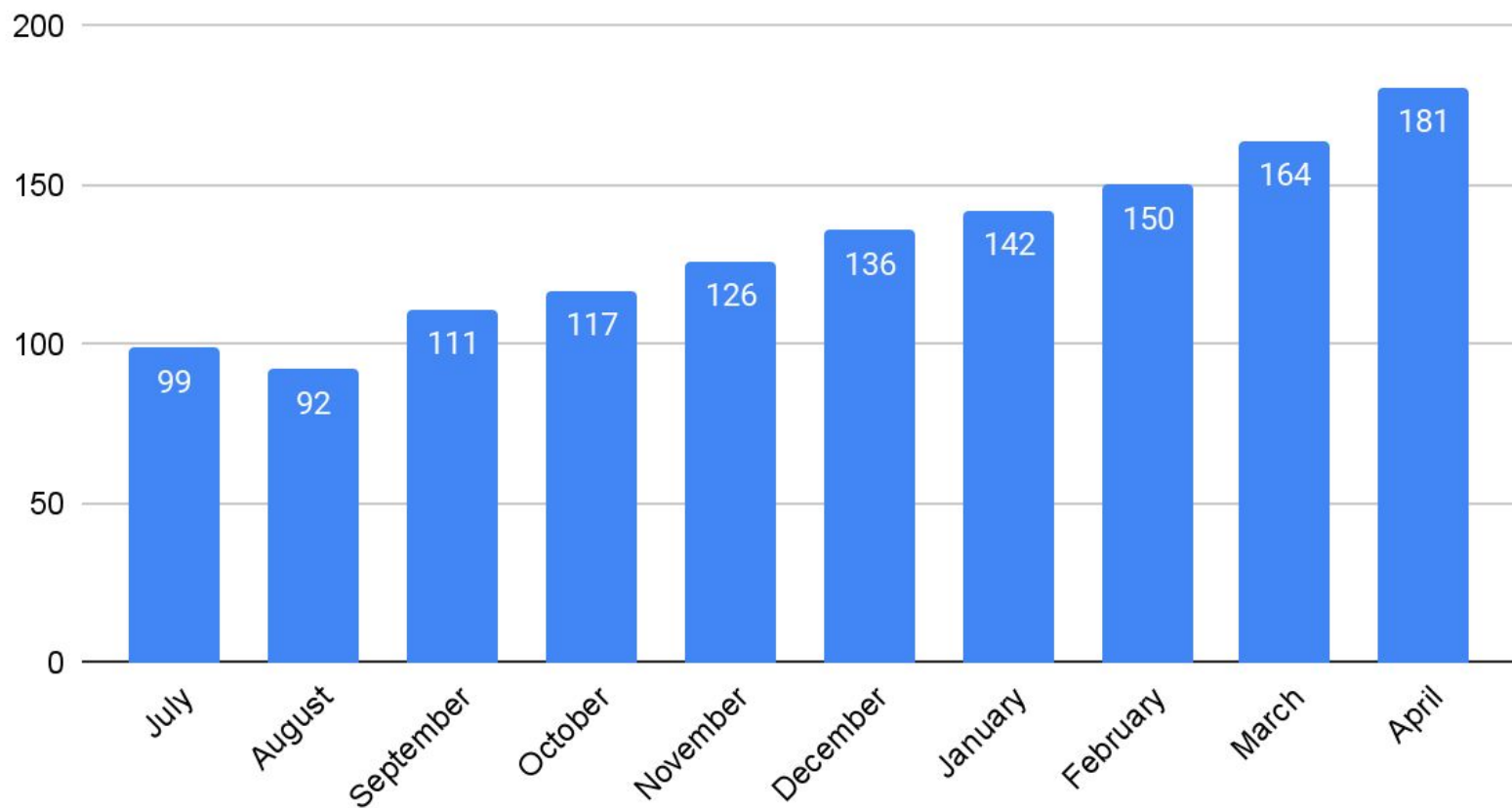
Check in by Age Group - APRIL 2023



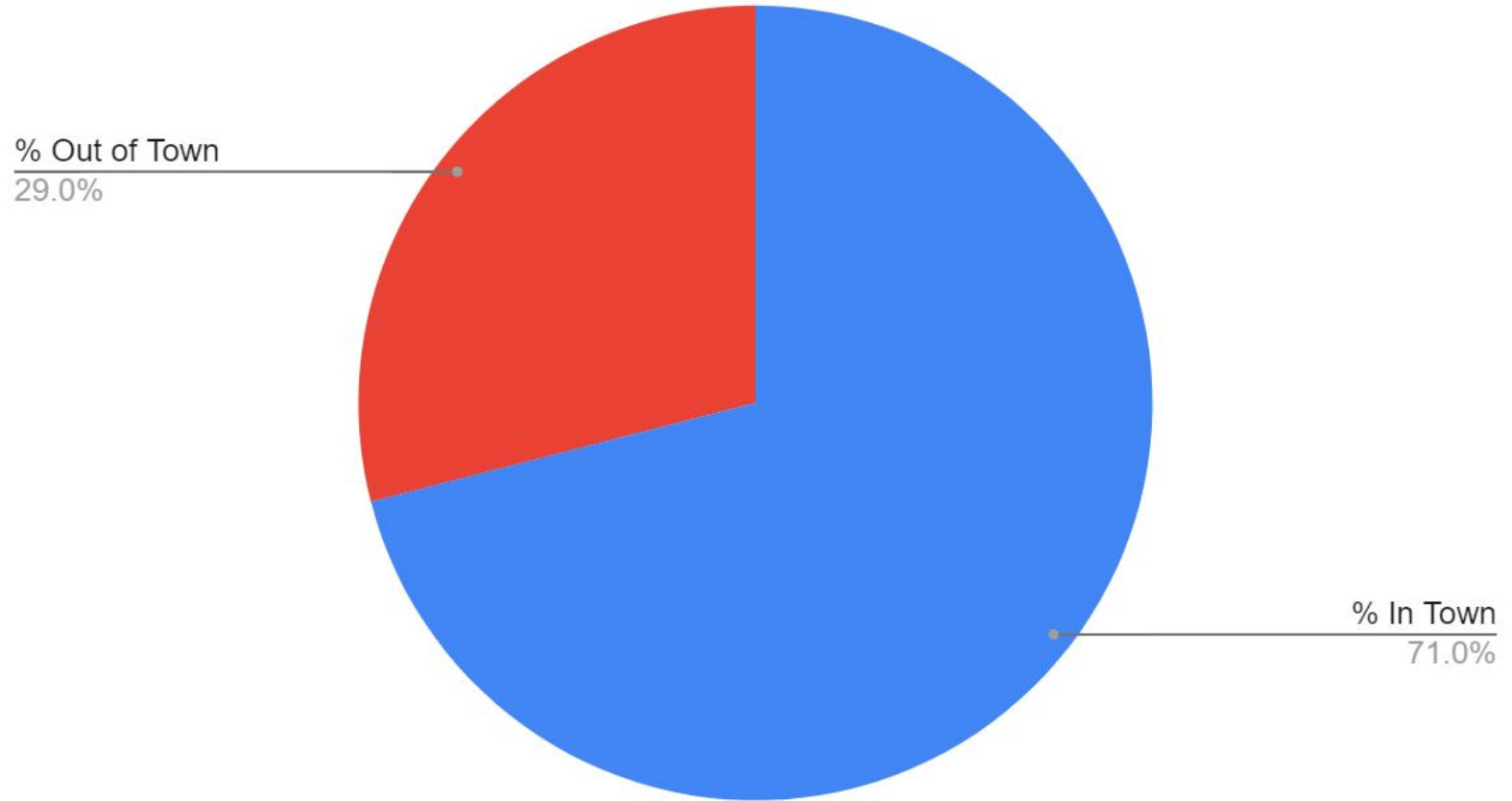

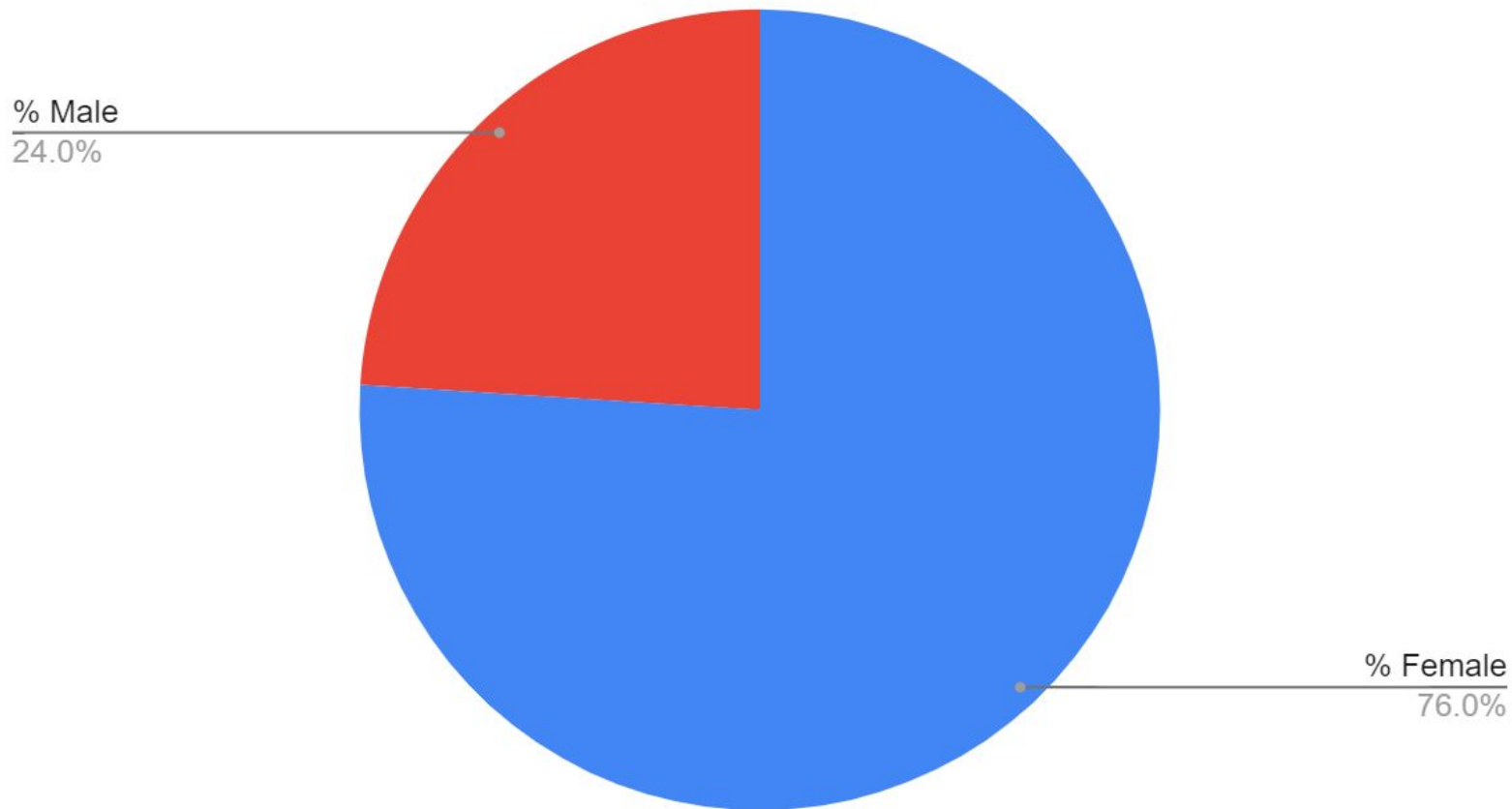
Average Daily Attendance FY23



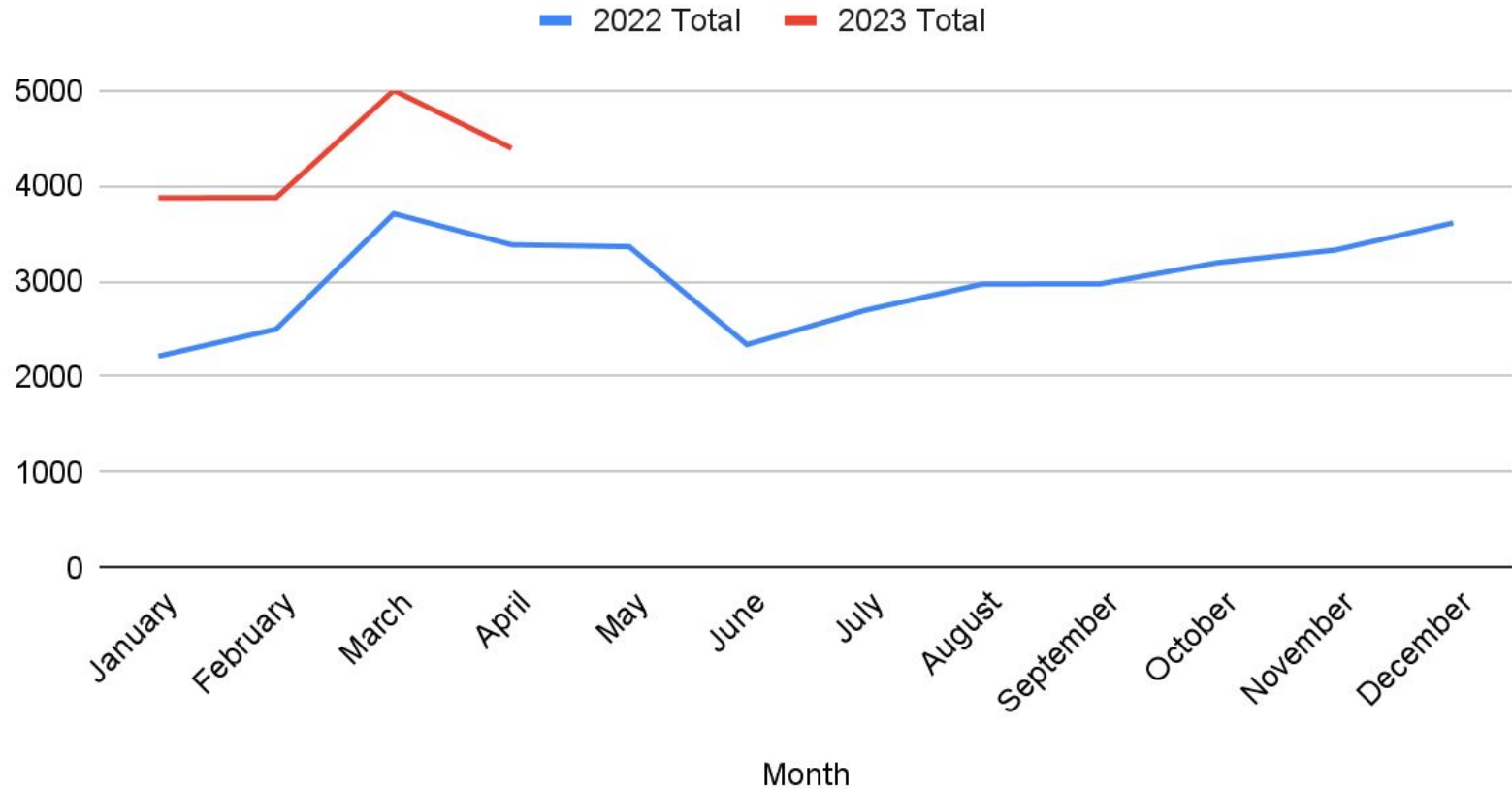
In Town and Out of Town Participation



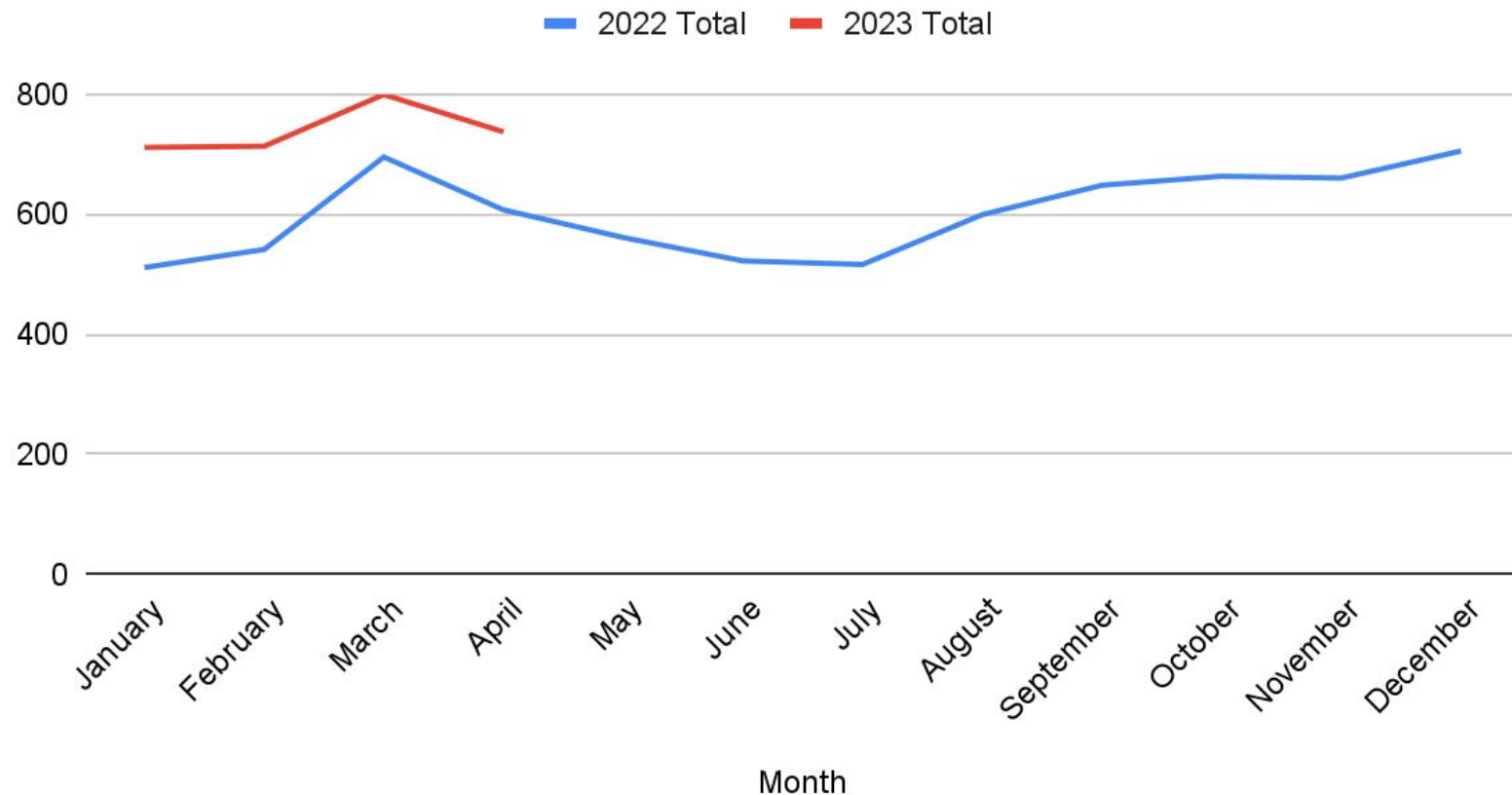
Female and Male Participation



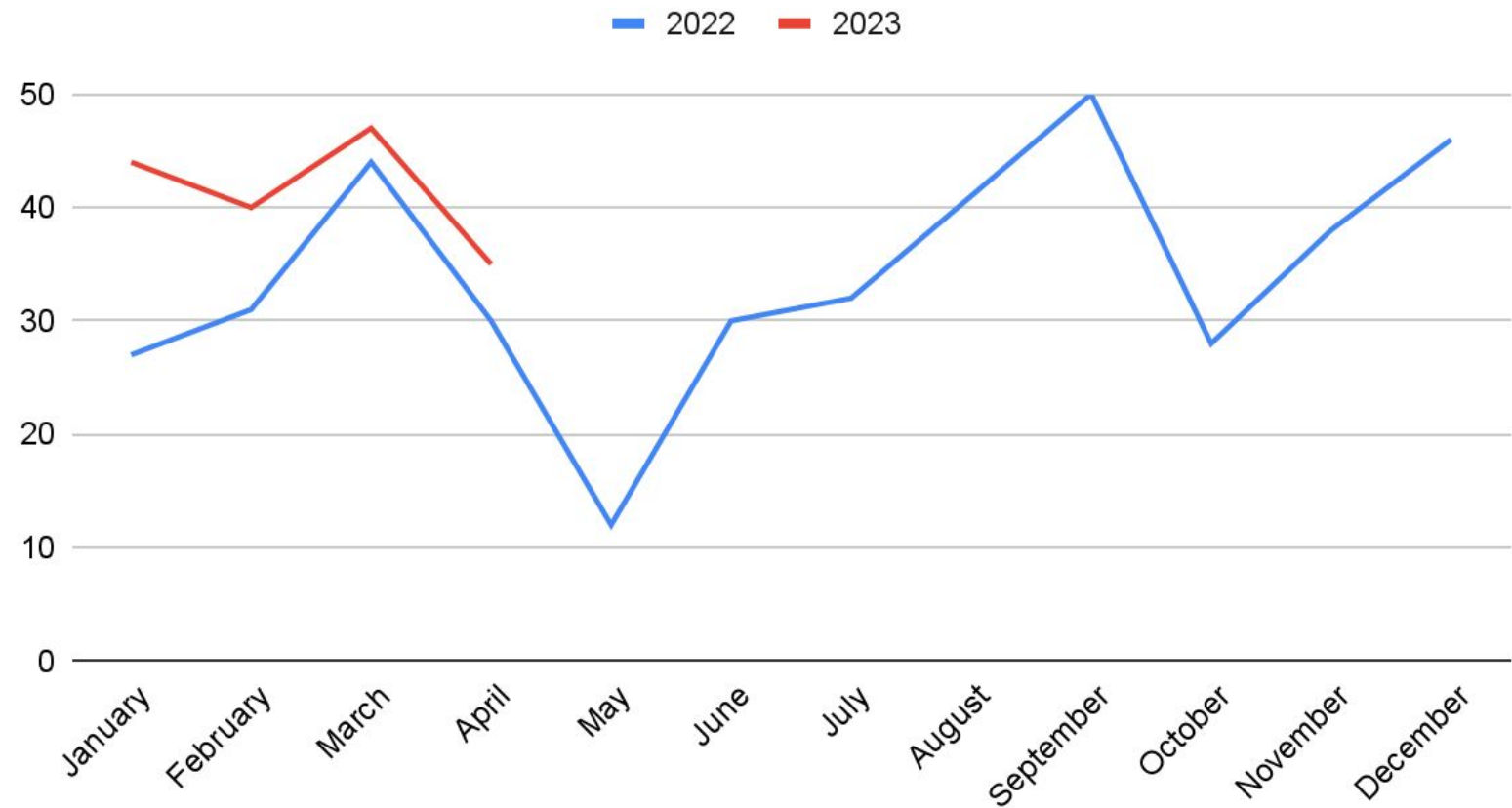
