2019 MUNICIPAL VULNERABILITY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM

- The Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness grant program (MVP) provides support for cities and towns in Massachusetts to begin the process of planning for climate resiliency.
- Communities who complete the MVP program become certified as an MVP community and are eligible for follow-up grant funding and other opportunities.
- The listening session is an opportunity for members of the public to learn about the MVP planning process, ask questions and provide additional input on concerns related to climate change resiliency and natural hazards.
- The Town partnered with Fuss and O'Neil, a state certified provider, to complete a comprehensive, baseline climate change and natural hazard vulnerability assessment and develop a list of priority actions for the town.
