FOLLOWING ARE THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE BOARD OF SEWER & WATER COMMISSIONERS SHOULD THEY APPROVE AN IRRIGATION SYSTEM AT YOUR PROPERTY

The system shall be designed and installed by a licensed irrigation contractor who shall submit certification of specifications compliance to the Water Department upon completion of the installation. The system shall at a minimum be equipped with the following components to avoid unnecessary operation and to protect public health.

- A timing device that is capable of conforming to any and all outside water use restrictions that may be imposed by the Board of Sewer & Water Commissioners.
- A soil moisture sensing device that will prevent unnecessary operation.
- A rain sensing device that will prevent unnecessary operation of the system during rainfall events of 1/8" or more.
- A flow sensing automatically activated master valve that is connected to the system control timer to prohibit flows to the system outside of the programmed hours of operation.
- An approved backflow prevention device.
- The system shall not be permanently activated until such time that the licensed installer provides proof of specifications compliance and an inspection has been performed by the Water Department
- Any system not in conformance shall be disconnected from the Town of Walpole Public Water Supply
