<u>Highway Department</u> – Town wide chain link fence repairs (High School and Woodward Playground).

<u>Building Maintenance</u> – Sprinkler nitrogen system, ceiling replacement at various schools

**Emergency Management** - OPR Antenna relocation

<u>Parks Department</u> – Replacement of mower, purchase underground moisture sensors and rotary cutting deck attachment

**School Department** – Technology, replacement of phone system

<u>Inspectional Services</u> – Permitting software.
