## Robbins Road Drop-Off Recycling Yard Waste

Check with the compost schedule or Health Dept. for Saturday hours as they change throughout the year. Open Wednesdays from 9 am to 12 pm year-round. Sticker is required from the Collector's Office at Town Hall.

### Paper & Cardboard

Roll off container can be used at the Robbins Road Compost Site for paper and cardboard recycling during the hours the compost site is open. No sticker is required. Boxes must be broken down and flattened.

### Fluorescent Bulbs

Monthly drop-off (June – Oct.) located at the Robbins Road Compost Site. Must Call Board of Health office for dates. 508-660-7321.

## Seasonal & Scheduled Curbside Collections

### Christmas Trees

Collection-month of January by DPW. Remove tinsel, twine, ornaments, etc. Make sure tree is not covered with snow. Or bring to Robbins Road compost site when open.

### Hazardous Waste

Sat. May 6, 2023 from 9am-12pm located at the Fisher School. \*Please note that latex paint is not considered hazardous and can be put out with your normal household trash. Cans must be dried out and lids must be open.

### Clothes, rags, shoes

Place in Bay State Textiles receptacles outside any Walpole Public School

### Tires

You can call the Norfolk County Mosquito Control Project to pick up your used tires (781-762-3681) for free. There is a limit.

### Televisions/Computer Monitors

Monthly drop off (June – Oct.) must call Board of Health office to schedule drop-off. There is a cost dependent on its size.

## Other recycling

### Cell Phones & Mercury Thermometers

Bring to Board of Health office during regular office hours.

## 2022-2023 Collection Calendar

### RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Recycling bins are collected every other week at your house on your regular trash collection day. Half the Town is collected on one week, while the other half of the Town is collected the other week. Check with the Walpole Health Department to see if your street is collected on a shaded or unshaded week or go to the website <http://www.walpole-ma.gov/solid-waste-recycling>

### HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday. **Holidays are circled.**
