The Following is a Representative List of the Types of Materials That Will Be Accepted:

GENERAL HOUSEHOLD

Acids
Aerosol cans
Artist supplies (e.g., adhesives, dyes, lead pencils, etc.)
Asbestos (*Must be wetted & placed in double plastic bag*)
Chemistry set chemicals
Flammable liquids / fire starters
Fiberglass resins
Floor care products / wax stripper
Furniture, floor, & metal polishes
Hobby supplies (e.g., rubber cement, airplane glue, etc.)
Metal cleaners, ammonia cleaners
Moth balls / crystals
Oil-based paint, varnish, stain, shellac, paint strippers
Photography chemicals
Rug & upholstery cleaners
Solvent adhesives
Turpentine, paint thinner
Wood preservatives

LAWN/GARDEN

2,4,5 Trichlorophenoxyacetic Acid (Phenoxy Herbicides)
Cesspool cleaners
Fertilizers
Flea / tick powder
Fungicides
Herbicides
Insecticides
No-pest strips
Pesticides
Poisons
Weed killers

BATHROOM

Floor/Toilet cleaners

COSMETICS

Aerosol deodorant
Hair coloring
Nail polish remover

KITCHEN

Drain cleaners
Lighter fluid
Oven cleaners

LAUNDRY

Brighteners
Chlorine bleach
Detergents
Spray starch
Spot removers
Softeners
Whiteners

AUTOMOTIVE

Brake fluid
Carburetor cleaner
Degreasers
Engine solvent
Radiator flush

Transmission fluid
Waste fuels (e.g., gasoline, kerosene)
