In my opinion the ZBA must issue the condition requiring that Omni build the appropriate test wells and formulate a comprehensive monitoring regiment, which is essential when construction of this magnitude is proposed in our public water supply. Mass Housing should support this necessary condition after mass housing issued the comprehensive permit for the Preserve that destroyed our future wellfield site. Baker Hughes performed the necessary testing that found the contamination that Baker Hughes addressed by pumping the contaminated water from the ground then treated the water and returned the water to the ground. A consulting firm like IEP must perform this very important function.

There may already be test wells on Omni's property from other studies. Pumps are inserted and removed for the test then the well is capped after the test for later use. The well itself is normally never removed. Baker Hughes may allow Omni to pay for testing of their test wells. I am reaching out to Donald Yonicka and Jack Jemsek two world-renowned Drinking Water protector experts they will know where the test wells are best deployed. Of course, a Scientist is needed to determine the purity of the water drawn from the test wells, and track any contamination from the Omni project. Unfortunately Omni will be responsible for all contamination discovered on their property in the Town of Walpole's public water supply.
