MONTHLY DESIGN PROGRESS REPORT No. 106 BLACKBURN & UNION PRIVILEGES SUPERFUND SITE For April 2019

Report Date: May 10, 2019

This Monthly Progress Report is submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) documenting the activities completed during the month of April 2019 at the Blackburn & Union Privileges Superfund Site.

- 1. Activities that have been taken toward achieving compliance with the Consent Decree (including work plans, plans and other deliverables completed and submitted to USEPA/MassDEP):
 - a. On April 3, 2019, submitted to USEPA a Revised Contractor Site Management Plan Section 12 Amendment (detailing planned water management activities in Area 3). A Conditional Approval letter for this submittal was received from USEPA on April 15, 2019
 - b. On April 16, 2019, received from USEPA a conditional approval letter regarding the March 19, 2019 submittal of a report from the fall 2018 post-restoration vegetation monitoring of the restored wetland area West of South Street at the Former Mill Tailrace.
 - c. At West of South Street Site, conducted perimeter air monitoring, completed installation and backfill of the groundwater collection trench, installed the vinyl sheet piling, conducted post-construction inspection at residences on Clark Avenue, conducted soil placement and grading, completed installation of the influent line, electrical conduits and storm drain piping, and continued treatment/discharge of the construction water generated from the work.
 - d. Continued excavation activities at Lewis Pond for the Sediment and Floodplain Soil Remedial Action. Activities included: completed excavation and backfill placement in Area 2A, operated the construction water treatment system, staging, drying and transport of sediment/soil for off-site disposal, begin removal of access road to Areas 1 and 2, and conducted perimeter air monitoring.
- 2. Summary of results of sampling, tests and all other data received or generated:
 - a. None this reporting period.
- 3. Activities planned for the next month and schedule update:
 - a. Planned activities associated with the Groundwater and Surface Water remedy, West of South Street include: conduct dewatering of the groundwater collection trench and operation of the groundwater treatment system, as needed, complete installation of pump and piping in vault, complete site grading, complete restoration, install monitoring wells, and begin full-time operation of the groundwater treatment system.
 - b. Planned activities associated with the Lewis Pond Sediment and Floodplain Soil Remedial Action include: complete sheet pile installation in Area 3, begin excavation and off-site disposal of material located in Area 3, placement of backfill in Area 3, operate (as needed) the temporary construction water treatment system, complete removal of haul road and install plantings and in Areas 1, 2, and 2A, continue perimeter air monitoring, and continue conducting weekly construction progress meetings with USEPA/MassDEP.
 - c. In support of institutional control development, continue review and communication with the Town of Walpole relative to the as-built package associated with the Town development of the East of South Street parcels.

- 4. Delays encountered or anticipated that may affect the future schedule for implementation of the work and associated mitigation efforts:
 - a. None this reporting period.
- 5. Work plan or schedule modifications proposed to USEPA or approved by USEPA:

- 6. Activities undertaken in support of the Community Relations Plan during the previous month and planned for the following month:
 - a. The Settling Defendants will continue to support USEPA in its communications with the local residents and other stakeholders relative to remedy design considerations and remedial action implementation. This includes providing updates on the work at the West of South Street Site and at the Lewis Pond Site.

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
