Walpole Precinct One.

All of that portion of Norfolk County bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of Main St and Plimpton St, and proceeding northerly along Main St to the Norwood/Walpole town line, and proceeding easterly along the Norwood/Walpole town line to Providence Hwy, and proceeding southerly along Providence Hwy to Coney St, and proceeding northerly along Coney St to Pleasant St, and proceeding southerly along Pleasant St to Old Post Rd, and proceeding southerly along Old Post Rd to Polley Ln, and proceeding westerly along Polley Ln to Short St, and proceeding westerly along Short St to East St, and proceeding westerly along East St to Everett St, and proceeding westerly along Everett St to Plimpton St, and proceeding northerly along Plimpton St to the point of beginning.

Walpole Precinct Two.

Walpole Precinct Four.

All of that portion of Norfolk County bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of Main St and Oak St, and proceeding northerly along Main St to Common St, and proceeding southerly along Common St to Massachusetts Ave, and proceeding easterly along Massachusetts Ave to Stone St, and proceeding easterly along Stone St to Washington St, and proceeding southerly along Washington St to Common St, and proceeding southerly along Common St to Old Post Rd, and proceeding northerly along Old Post Rd to the Sharon/Walpole town line, and proceeding southerly along the Sharon/Walpole town line to the Foxborough/Walpole town line, and proceeding westerly along the Foxborough/Walpole town line to Boston-Providence Tpke, and proceeding easterly along Boston-Providence Tpke to Irving Drive feature extension boundary, and proceeding northerly along Irving Drive feature extension to Irving Dr, and proceeding northerly along Irving Dr to northerly Maude Ter, and proceeding westerly along Maude Ter to Harold Rd, and proceeding northerly along Harold Rd to South St, and proceeding northerly along South St to Oak St, and proceeding northerly along Oak St to the point of beginning.

Walpole Precinct Five.

All of that portion of Norfolk County bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the Norfolk/Walpole town line and the Foxborough/Walpole town line, and proceeding easterly along the Norfolk/Walpole town line to West St, and proceeding easterly along West St to power line, and proceeding easterly along power line to 5R Birch Street/555 Cedar St, and proceeding easterly along 5R Birch Street/555 Cedar St to its easterly corner, and proceeding southerly to Industrial Rd feature extension at Main St, and proceeding along Industrial Rd to former Conrail RR, and proceeding northerly along former Conrail RR to South St, and proceeding southerly along South St to Harold Rd, and proceeding southerly along Harold Rd to Maude Ter, and proceeding easterly along Maude Ter to Irving Dr, and proceeding southerly along Irving Dr to the center of Irving Drive feature extension, and proceeding southerly along the center of Irving Drive feature extension to Boston-Providence Tpke, and proceeding westerly along Boston-Providence Tpke to the Foxborough/Walpole town line, and proceeding westerly along the Foxborough/Walpole town line to the point of beginning.

Walpole Precinct Six.

All of that portion of Norfolk County bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the Medfield/Walpole town line and the Norfolk/Walpole town line, and proceeding easterly along the Medfield/Walpole town line to Elm St, and proceeding southerly along Elm St to Main St, and proceeding southerly along Main St to Oak St, and proceeding southerly along Oak St to South St, and proceeding southerly along South St to former Conrail RR, and proceeding southerly along former Conrail RR to Industrial Rd, and proceeding westerly along Industrial Rd to Industrial Rd feature

extension at Main St, and proceeding northerly to the easterly corner of 5R Birch Street/555 Cedar St, and proceeding westerly along 5R Birch Street/555 Cedar St to power line, and proceeding westerly along power line to West St, and proceeding westerly along West St to the Norfolk/Walpole town line, and proceeding northerly along the Norfolk/Walpole town line to the point of beginning.

Walpole Precinct Seven.

All of that portion of Norfolk County bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of Elm St and the Medfield/Walpole town line, and proceeding northerly along Medfield/Walpole town line to High St, and proceeding easterly along High St to Homeward Ln, and proceeding easterly along Homeward Ln to Heritage Dr, and proceeding southerly and easterly along Heritage Dr to an unnamed brook, and proceeding southerly along an unnamed brook to a point, and proceeding easterly along the same unnamed brook to North St, and proceeding southerly along North St to Gould St, and proceeding easterly along Gould St to Main St, and proceeding southerly along Main St to Plimpton St, and proceeding easterly along Plimpton St to MBTA RR, and proceeding southerly along MBTA RR to Elm St, and proceeding northerly along Elm St to the Medfield/Walpole town line, and proceeding northerly along the Medfield/Walpole town line to the point of beginning.

Walpole Precinct Eight.

All of that portion of Norfolk County bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the Medfield/Walpole town line and High St, and proceeding northerly along the Medfield/Walpole town line to the Dover/Walpole town line, and proceeding easterly along the Dover/Walpole town line to the Westwood/Walpole town line, and proceeding southerly along the Westwood/Walpole town line to the Norwood/Walpole town line, and proceeding southerly along the Norwood/Walpole town line to Main St, and proceeding southerly along Main St to Gould St, and proceeding westerly along Gould St to North St, and proceeding northerly along North St to an unnamed brook, and proceeding westerly along an unnamed brook to a point, and proceeding northerly along an unnamed brook to Heritage Dr, and proceeding westerly and northerly along Heritage Dr to Homeward Ln, and proceeding westerly along Homeward Ln to High St, and proceeding westerly along High St to the point of beginning.
