Animal Control Officer

The Town of Walpole is seeking a qualified individual to fill the role of Animal Control Officer. This position is responsible for investigative, enforcement and public relations work in implementing by-laws and statutes concerned with the licensing of and the control of the dog population of the Town; related work as required. Additional Responsibilities include but not limited to: Explaining applicable statues & by-laws which regulate the control of animals within the town; Assists residents by resolving animal problem complaints. Issues oral and/or written warnings or citations to law violators; enforcing leash law throughout the Town; Picks up & disposes of dead or injured animals; Answers & attempts to resolve complaints relating to nuisances due to unwanted wild animal activity, barking dogs or dogs trespassing on private property.

Desirable Qualifications & Skills: Candidate must be high school graduate with some experience in handling dogs or other animals. Considerable knowledge of the by-laws and the statutes pertaining to responsibilities of owners and keepers as to behavior of dogs; ability to handle dogs; ability to deal appropriately and effectively with the public.

Special Qualifications: Must possess a valid state driver's license issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles. A "License to Carry" firearms' permit is preferred, but not required.
