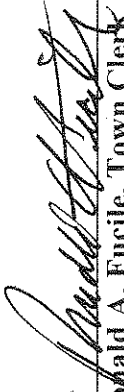


State Primary, September 6, 2012

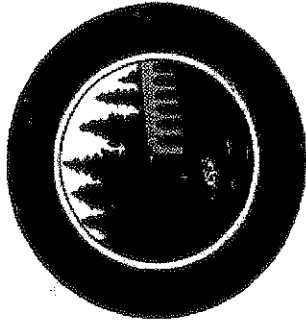

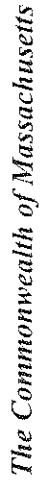
