**ARTICLE 1:** To see if the Town will vote pursuant to G.L. c.40, §59 and G.L. c.23A, §§3E and 3F to: (a) approve the Tax Increment Financing ("TIF") Agreement between Siemens Health Care Diagnostics and the Town of Walpole, substantially in the form as is on file with the Town Clerk (the "TIF Agreement"), for property located at 333 Coney Street and Moose Hill Road (Map 29, Lot 69 and Map 28, Lot 186) and as described more fully in the TIF Agreement, which TIF Agreement provides for real estate tax exemptions at the exemption rate schedule set forth therein; (b) authorize the Board of Selectmen to execute the TIF Agreement, and any documents relating thereto; and (c) authorize the Board of Selectmen to approve submission of the TIF Agreement and Certified Project Application, and any associated documents to the Massachusetts Economic Assistance Coordinating Council, all relating to the project as described in the TIF Agreement to be located in the 333 Coney Street EOA and Certified Project Application, and take such other and further action as may be necessary or appropriate to obtain EACC approval, implement these documents and carry out the purposes of this article; or take any other action relative thereto. (Petition of the Board of Selectmen)
